430		ASTILBE FANAL RHINELAND PINK Beautiful bloom clusters to provide lovely summer color in shady areas of the landscape. The tall, feathery, clear pink blooms rise above the mound of lush green foliage, adding a light, airy quality. Ideal for creating a graceful border, or a dynamic mass planting. Thrives in dappled or full shade. An herbaceous perennial.	448		LEUCANTHEMUM-SHASTA DAISY An outstanding dwarf form with long-lasting, large, semi-double flowers that rise out of a lush mound of coarse, dark green, disease resistant foliage in summer and again in the fall. The soft lemon yellow blooms age to a crisp white. Excellent for containers and sunny borders, with great tolerance to heat, drought, and humidity. An herbaceous perennial.
432		CATMINT NEPETA BLUE WONDER A sun-loving perennial with a long blooming time and large deep blue flowers it will grow best in a sunny spot. Keep in mind that even though it only grows about 12 inches tall it will respond well to cutting back 2/3 in July to promote re-blooming in August to summer's end.	450		LITHODORA GRACE WARD Beautiful deep blue flowers cover this wonderful sprawling groundcover. The slightly mounded form adds softness and color to the top of retaining walls. Works well as a rock garden accent, softly flowing between boulders. Performs best with some shade in extremely hot areas. Evergreen.
434		DIANTHUS This perennial produces excellent uniform flowers from spring thru early summer. They have a clove-like scent and grow about 6 to 8 inches in a full sun location.	452		PHLOX FOREVER PINK A very colorful addition to any perennial garden phlox will bloom in early summer and then again in early fall. They will grow 12 to 16 inches and have a slight fragrance. Besides enjoying sun to part sun they are easily cared for.
436		DEAD NETTLE: LAMIUM PURPLE DRAGON This superb choice forms a spreading patch of small silver leaves with a wide green edge. Clusters of deep magenta-purple flowers are larger than other varieties. These flowers appear in spring and will then continue off and on until fall. This perennial enjoys morning sun but after being established it is fairly tolerant of dry shade. It will only grow 6 to 8 inches and is not enjoyed by rabbits.	454		RUDEBECKIA GOLSTRUM Also called black Eyed Susan. Among the best border perennials available. Plants make a bushy, upright clump with a profuse display of brown-eyed, golden-orange daisies from midsummer through the fall. While the plants are well rooted and strong they be be small for early orders
438		HEUCHERA Heavy foliage marbled with green and cream color this Heuchera is a must have for the shade garden. An exciting feature of this hummingbird attractor is its flower shoots. These shoots appear early to midsummer. This perennial will grow 10 to 15 inches tall with average water needs.	456		SALVIA MAY NIGHT What a plant butterflies and hummingbirds love it, Deer hate it. Its drought and heat tolerant. Cutting flowers for bouquets encourages new flowers.
440		CREeping PHLOX-FORT HILL Masses of dainty, deep pinkish-rose flowers cover the top of this mat-forming creeper for a long period. Creates a carpet of color for use as a groundcover. Tolerates some drought. Evergreen perennial in when cascading over walls.	458		STACHUS HUMMELO A stunning choice for the Perennial Plant Association's Plant of the Year 2019! They state "As trouble free and dependable as it is eye-catching", and we agree. A wealth of rose-lavender spikes all summer are particularly fabulous in massed plantings.
442		JACOBS LADDER HEAVENLY HABIT Fragrant, blue flowers is a unique feature of this perennial. It will grow 18 to 20 inches tall blooming primarily in early summer. Cutting this plant back by 1/3 after blooming may encourage sporadic re-blooming in late summer. Preferring afternoon shade it is best to water this plant in the morning.	460		STELLA D'ORO DAYLILY This is one of the top daylilies in the country. It will bloom thru the summer and into the fall growing 14 to 16 inches tall. The bright yellow blooms are fragrant and grow in sun or half sun. Besides being very low maintenance this daylily does attract butterfly.
446		LIRIOPE: There's no groundcover known to humankind that's as successful as liriope at preventing erosion on even the steepest hillsides, And surviving wet or bone dry conditions, and doing all that in full sun or deep shade.	462		VIOLA HALO LILAC Large, long-lasting, lilac blue flowers with white eyes and yellow centers above heart-shaped leaves. Ideal for border edges or in a moist woodland location. Takes dry to medium soil in shade, needs consistent moisture in sun. Ideal for underplantings, as a groundcover, or on banks.
