Thrives in dappled or full shade.			An outstanding dwarf form with long-lasting, large, semi-double flowers that rise out of a lush mound of coarse, dark green, disease resistant foliage in summer and again in the fall. The soft lemon yellow blooms age to a crisp white. Excellent for containers and sunny borders, with great tolerance to heat, drou and humidity. An herbaceous perennial.
