Comments: Large, delicious, bright red, high yielding fruits are borne in abundance starting midseason and continuing to frost. Good foliage protection prevents sun scald. Better Boy is highly adaptable and thrives in most climates and has very good disease resistance.

Some tomato cultivars will be marked with disease resistance codes, signifying that the plant is immune to a certain disease shown below:

- A Alternaria stem canker
- F— Fusarium wilt
- **FF** Fusarium races 1 and 2
- **FFF** Fusarium races 1, 2 and 3
- N Nematodes
- T <u>Tobacco mosaic virus</u>
- St <u>Stemphylium</u> gray leaf spot
- V Verticillium wilt
