GROWER'S COMMENTS AND GENERAL INFORMATION			
The soil must be thoroughly warmed. Minimum soil temperature for germination is 70°F.			
Optimum soil temperature is 95°F. Pumpkins are very sensitive to the cold.			
Pick a site with full sun (to light shade).			
Pumpkins are big greedy feeders. They prefer very rich soil that is well-drained and not too			
soggy. Mix lots of compost and aged mature into the planting site before you sow seeds or tranplant.			
Select a site with lots of space for the sprawling vines. Vine varieties need 50 to 100 square feet			
per hill.
